
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 3.2% since 2019, growing by 999. Population is expected to increase by 3.1% between 2024 and 2029, adding 1,000.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 5.4% in Delta County, CO from 10,449 to 11,016. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 1.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 58.8% to 55.9% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **17.3% of Delta County, CO residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.2% below the national average), and **6.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.








Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Delta County, CO had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 4.47%, increasing from 3.23% 5 years before.






Delta County, CO has 4,822 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 6,450.


Retirement risk is high in Delta County, CO. The national average for an area this size is 9,583 people 55 or older, while there are 13,624 here.

Delta County, CO has 2,727 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 1,614.


Delta County, CO has 0.82 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.










Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP








Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings








